

We are the host church this year.


June  $17^{th} - 22^{nd} \& 28^{th} - 29^{th}$ 

The group arrives on Tuesday, June 17<sup>th</sup> ; they learn their program, music, skits and puppet shows, and practice bike rides. They work on discipleship habits, with devotions and prayer. We commission them on Sunday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> and off they go to other churches. They arrive back at LLLC Saturday afternoon, June 28<sup>th</sup>. On Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup> they present a program during the worship service before heading back to their homes. We will have the opportunity to provide some meals and fellowship with these dedicated young people.

The congregation is blessed and encouraged by Spoke Folk. The tour leads an engaging hourlong program for the host congregation, which includes contemporary Christian music, puppets, skits and testimonies.

As they interact with and are led in worship by youth from across the country that are excited about their faith in Jesus, members of your congregation of all ages will benefit from your church hosting Spoke Folk.





## **Introducing Pastor Dan**

I was born and grew up in East Africa, Ethiopia, in Oromia Region speaking Oromo language known as "Afaan Oromoo". I was baptized in the Ethiopian Orthodox church as a kid. I was a high school student when I was invited to visit the Lutheran church in the area, which was a special moment in my life. I was deeply touched by the gospel message of the pastor, and I have since been a follower of Christ. I joined the Lutheran church and became part of the faith community. Years later, I felt God's calling consistent-

ly and finally went to Mekane Yesus Lutheran Seminary in Ethiopian. Having graduated from seminary, I taught at a Bible College for two years until I received a scholarship from the Lutheran seminary in Norway for master's degree in philosophy of religion.

I completed my study and came to the United States and joined the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Gettysburg (Currently known as United Lutheran Seminary) for Master of Divinity to train for ministry in American cultural context. During my study at Gettysburg Seminary, I completed the ELCA candidacy process and got approved for ordination in Washington, D.C. Synod. Soon after that I was offered a CPE Residency Program at MedStar Washington Hospital Center in Washington, D.C. I completed five units of CPE and worked as a chaplain in the hospital for several years in the east coast. While working as a chaplain and preaching in various congregations on weekends, I decided to pursue a doctorate program and went to Graduate Theological Union (GTU) in Berkeley, California where I received a PhD in systematic theology. While in California, I accepted a call to serve a congregation in the beautiful city of Santa Rosa in Sierra Pacific Synod until I moved back to the east coast. I came back to the east coast and received a call at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Hershey, PA in Lower Susquehanna Synod.

I am currently serving at Faith Lutheran Church in Isanti. My wife and I enjoy living here and serving God and people of God. We love nature, hiking, biking, etc.
