

Long Lake Lutheran Church is looking for an enthusiastic individual or team of individuals to serve in the capacity of providing media/audio visual (AV) and information technology (IT) support to staff and congregation members. Media/AV support is primarily provided on Sundays for approximately 5 hours per week for social media and streaming of church services. IT support occurs Monday through Friday for approximately 10 hours per week at a work schedule that will be determined.

Candidates may apply to provide media/AV support, IT support, or both. Successful candidates will hold a high school diploma, be an advanced user of Microsoft Office products, have 3 years of experience providing AV/IT support, and familiarity with streaming platforms.

The starting salary is anticipated to be between \$21.00 and \$26.00 per hour with starting salary based on experience. 
