Psalm 118:14–29

L: ¹⁴The LORD is my strength and my might; he has become my salvation.

A: ¹⁵**There are glad songs of victory in the tents of the righteous: "The right hand of the LORD does valiantly;**

L: ¹⁶the right hand of the LORD is exalted; the right hand of the LORD does valiantly."

A: ¹⁷**I shall not die, but I shall live, and recount the deeds of the LORD.**

L: ¹⁸The LORD has punished me severely, but he did not give me over to death.

A: ¹⁹**Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the LORD.**

L: ²⁰This is the gate of the LORD; the righteous shall enter through it.

A: ²¹**I thank you that you have answered me and have become my salvation.**

L: ²²The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone.

A: ²³**This is the LORD's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.**

L: ²⁴This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

A: ²⁵**Save us, we beseech you, O LORD! O LORD, we beseech you, give us success!**

L: ²⁶Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the LORD. We bless you from the house of the LORD.

A: ²⁷**The LORD is God, and he has given us light. Bind the festal procession with branches, up to the horns of the altar.**

L: ²⁸You are my God, and I will give thanks to you; you are my God, I will extol you.

A: ²⁹**O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.**

Acts 5:27–32

Peter has been arrested for proclaiming the good news of Jesus' death and resurrection. His response to the charges of the high priest summarizes the early church's proclamation of forgiveness of sin through repentance.

²⁷When they had brought them, they had them stand before the council. The high priest questioned them, ²⁸saying, "We gave you strict orders not to teach in this name, yet here you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and you are determined to bring this man's blood on us." ²⁹But Peter and the apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than any human authority. ³⁰The God of our ancestors raised up Jesus, whom you had killed by hanging him on a tree. ³¹God exalted him at his right hand as Leader and Savior that he might give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins. ³²And we are witnesses to these things, and so is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey him."
