Please Read Responsively: Psalm 49:1-12

L: Hear this, all you peoples; give ear, all you who dwell in the world,

ALL: you of high degree and low, rich and poor together.

L: My mouth shall speak of wisdom, and my heart shall meditate on understanding.

ALL: I will incline my ear to a proverb and set forth my riddle upon the harp.

L: Why should I be afraid in evil days, when the wickedness of those at my heels surrounds me,

ALL: the wickedness of those who put their trust in their own prowess, and boast of their great riches?

L: One can never redeem another, or give to God the ransom for another's life;

ALL: for the ransom of a life is so great that there would never be enough to pay it,

L: in order to live forever and ever and never see the grave.

ALL: For we see that the wise die also; like the dull and stupid they perish and leave their wealth to those who come after them.

L: Their graves shall be their homes forever, their dwelling places from generation to generation, though they had named lands after themselves.

ALL: Even though honored, they cannot live forever; they are like the beasts that perish.

A Reading of the Gospel of Luke 12:13-21

Someone in the crowd said to [Jesus,] "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the family inheritance with me." But he said to him, "Friend, who set me to be a judge or arbitrator over you?" And he said to them, "Take care! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; for one's life does not consist in the abundance of possessions." Then he told them a parable: "The land of a rich man produced abundantly. And he thought to himself, 'What should I do, for I have no place to store my crops?' Then he said, 'I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. And I will say to my soul, Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry.' But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life is being demanded of you. And the things you have prepared, whose will they be?' So it is with those who store up treasures for themselves but are not rich toward God."
