## **Please Read Responsively: Psalm 66: 1-9**

L: Be joyful in God, all you lands; be joyful, all the earth.

**ALL: Sing the glory of God's name; sing the glory of God's praise.**

L: Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! Because of your great strength your enemies cringe before you.

**ALL: All the earth bows down before you, sings to you, sings out your name."**

L: Come now and see the works of God, how awesome are God's deeds toward all people.

**ALL: God turned the sea into dry land, so that they went through the water on foot, and there we rejoiced in God.**

L: Ruling forever in might, God keeps watch over the nations; let no rebels exalt themselves.

**ALL: Bless our God, you peoples; let the sound of praise be heard.**

L: Our God has kept us among the living and has not allowed our feet to slip.

## **A Reading of the Gospel of Luke 10:1-11, 16-20**

After this the Lord appointed seventy others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go. He said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Go on your way. See, I am sending you out like lambs into the midst of wolves. Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals; and greet no one on the road. Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!' And if anyone is there who shares in peace, your peace will rest on that person; but if not, it will return to you. Remain in the same house, eating and drinking whatever they provide, for the laborer deserves to be paid. Do not move about from house to house. Whenever you enter a town and its people welcome you, eat what is set before you; cure the sick who are there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' But whenever you enter a town and they do not welcome you, go out into its streets and say, 'Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet, we wipe off in protest against you. Yet know this: the kingdom of God has come near.' "

"Whoever listens to you listens to me, and whoever rejects you rejects me, and whoever rejects me rejects the one who sent me."

The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, in your name even the demons submit to us!" He said to them, "I watched Satan fall from heaven like a flash of lightning. See, I have given you authority to tread on snakes and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing will hurt you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice at this, that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."
