Psalm 27

L: ¹The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

A: ²When evildoers assail me to devour my flesh — my adversaries and foes — they shall stumble and fall.

L: ³Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war rise up against me, yet I will be confident.

A: ⁴One thing I asked of the LORD, that will I seek after: to live in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in his temple.

L: ⁵For he will hide me in his shelter in the day of trouble; he will conceal me under the cover of his tent; he will set me high on a rock.

A: ⁶Now my head is lifted up above my enemies all around me, and I will offer in his tent sacrifices with shouts of joy; I will sing and make melody to the LORD.

L: ⁷Hear, O LORD, when I cry aloud, be gracious to me and answer me!

A: ⁸"Come," my heart says, "seek his face!" Your face, LORD, do I seek.

L: ⁹Do not hide your face from me. Do not turn your servant away in anger, you who have been my help. Do not cast me off, do not forsake me, O God of my salvation!

A: ¹⁰If my father and mother forsake me, the LORD will take me up.

L: ¹¹Teach me your way, O LORD, and lead me on a level path because of my enemies.

A: ¹²Do not give me up to the will of my adversaries, for false witnesses have risen against me, and they are breathing out violence.

L: ¹³I believe that I shall see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

A: ¹⁴Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!

Luke 13:31-35

³¹At that very hour some Pharisees came and said to him, "Get away from here, for Herod wants to kill you." ³²He said to them, "Go and tell that fox for me, 'Listen, I am casting out demons and performing cures today and tomorrow, and on the third day I finish my work.

³³Yet today, tomorrow, and the next day I must be on my way, because it is impossible for a prophet to be killed outside of Jerusalem.' ³⁴Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it! How often have I desired to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing!

³⁵See, your house is left to you. And I tell you, you will not see me until the time comes when you say, 'Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord.'"
