Reader: Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven,
whose sin is covered.

**All: Happy are those to whom the LORD imputes no iniquity,
and in whose spirit there is no deceit.**

Reader: While I kept silence, my body wasted away
through my groaning all day long.

**All: For day and night your hand was heavy upon me;
my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.**

Reader: Then I acknowledged my sin to you,
and I did not hide my iniquity;
I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD,"
and you forgave the guilt of my sin.

**All: Therefore let all who are faithful
offer prayer to you;
at a time of distress, the rush of mighty waters
shall not reach them.**

Reader: You are a hiding place for me;
you preserve me from trouble;
you surround me with glad cries of deliverance.

**All: I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go;
I will counsel you with my eye upon you.**

Reader: Do not be like a horse or a mule, without understanding,
whose temper must be curbed with bit and bridle,
else it will not stay near you.
Many are the torments of the wicked,
but steadfast love surrounds those who trust in the LORD.

**All: Be glad in the LORD and rejoice, O righteous,
and shout for joy, all you upright in heart.**

Galatians 2:15-21

¹⁵ We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; ¹⁶ yet we know that a person is justified not by the works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ. And we have come to believe in Christ Jesus, so that we might be justified by faith in Christ, and not by doing the works of the law, because no one will be justified by the works of the law. ¹⁷ But if, in our effort to be justified in Christ, we ourselves have been found to be sinners, is Christ then a servant of sin? Certainly not! ¹⁸ But if I build up again the very things that I once tore down, then I demonstrate that I am a transgressor. ¹⁹ For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live to God. I have been crucified with Christ; ²⁰ and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. ²¹ I do not nullify the grace of God; for if justification comes through the law, then Christ died for nothing.
