LLLC Scholarship Information

- Applicants must be a member of Long Lake Lutheran Church.
- Applicants must be currently attending a college or trade school and have completed at least one semester. (Undergraduate programs only)
- Each applicant may apply to the scholarship fund a maximum of two times. These two times must be in consecutive years.
- Scholarships will be awarded once per year for \$250 each.
- The Scholarship Committee will take into consideration special circumstances that are outside the limitations set by our guidelines.
- Applications can be found on the church website (www.longlakeluth.org) and at the church office.
- Students need to provide proof of enrollment and a GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Donations to the scholarship program will be graciously accepted at any time throughout the year. Make checks payable to **Long Lake Lutheran Church Scholarship Fund.**
- Scholarship applications are due on August 1st and awards will be announced September 1st.
